

## SCHEDULE 1

This Schedule sets out the terms of the Cricketer's employment which are personal to the Cricketer. The remaining terms and conditions of employment are as set out and agreed in the standard contract (of which this Schedule is a part) and Schedule 2 and these three documents taken together shall be the Agreement between the Parties.

### Part A

#### **1. Term**

The Term of the Agreement is from the Commencement Date to the Expiry Date inclusive.

#### **2. Place of Work**

The Cricketer's principal place of employment is [address] and he may be required to work at any place the Employer shall reasonably require. The Cricketer will also be required to travel within the United Kingdom and Ireland to fulfil his duties. The Cricketer will not be required to work for the Employer outside the United Kingdom and Ireland for more than 1 month during each calendar year during the Term on overseas tours or otherwise.

#### **3. Continuity of Employment**

For the purposes of continuity of employment, the Cricketer's employment with the Employer began on [commencement date of Cricketers first contract with Employer] and no prior service with any other employer shall count towards continuity of employment.

#### **4. Salary**
