The Hong Kong Cricket Club (HKCC) is a private members club established in 1851 and is situated in the heart of Hong Kong Island. Principally a Cricket Club, it also hosts numerous other core sports, additional recreational facilities and food and beverage outlets. The Club has almost 6,000 registered members and over 200 Staff.

With 12 senior and 20 junior cricket teams, HKCC provides a wide range of cricket playing opportunities across all ages and abilities through our established programmes coordinated by our professional coaching team and volunteers. Working alongside Cricket Hong Kong (CHK), the local governing body for cricket, we also provide opportunities within the local community through our school and charity programmes.

There are currently 5 competitive women and girls cricket teams - the HKCC Rebels (U11's) the HKCC Blazers (U19's) the HKCC Diamonds (Development League), the HKCC Cavaliers (Division 2) and the HKCC Willow Wielders (Division 1).

We are looking to appoint an enthusiastic and motivated individual who is passionate about cricket coaching and development. As well as working with our HKCC women and girl's pathway programmes, the incumbent will be responsible for driving cricket development within local schools and the community. You will be a team-player with excellent organisational and communication skills and a committed role model for women and girl's cricket.

The incumbent will report directly into the HKCC Head Cricket Coach who manages a team of 4 full-time and 6 part-time cricket coaches.

Responsibilities: Women and Girls cricket

- Be the point-of-contact for all cricket at HKCC
 - Administer, monitor, promote & evaluate all programmes at HKCC
 - Plan, deliver training and manage match days for the five HKCC competitive teams
 - Deliver 1-2-1 training sessions when requested by the Head Cricket Coach
- Convert Primary and Secondary school participants into our HKCC programmes to increase the number of players in our girls U11's and U19's teams

- Maintain and develop all-year round playing opportunities
- Deliver the on-going program on Wednesday afternoons and Saturday mornings - supporting the Mini-Rebels, Rebels & Blazers
- Assist in coaching HKCC junior teams
- Coach school holiday Sports Camps at HKCC
- Organise tours

CHK and the Community

- Work with CHK to deliver cricket in Primary and Secondary Schools.
- Increase the delivery of local community engagement through innovative courses and festivals with the view to converting these participants into HKCC players at all levels
- Maximise the opportunities for players to be involved in CHK programs such as Women's Premier League, Cricket Hong Kong National Development Team and Cricket Hong Kong National Team
- Increase the opportunities to get involved in Cricket Hong Kong coaching courses, umpiring courses and scoring courses
- Work with CHK on their strategic plan for cricket
- Provide opportunities for coaching exposure with the Cricket Hong Kong National Team
